Issues and Problems:

1. Continuing. The facilities available for training and testing instrument tasks are becoming more congested and constrained. We will write a letter to the FSDO outlining our concerns. Dave Vangsnes will lead this.
2. CFI Checkrides: There are 3 DPE's that are approved for initial CFI Airplane Checkrides. All examiners are noticing that there are problems with scenario based testing for CFI Applicants. NOTE FROM Phil Remmel. We need to talk to recommending instructors about scenario based training for CFI Applicants. There is also a lack of knowledge with the FOI.
