### Standing Topics:

#### Issues and problems:

Many DPE are noticing that there are still many problems with applicant pre-flight planning area of operation and those tasks.

**FAA Publication Changes (PTS, Handbooks, Orders, etc)** Notice is out for the comment period for the Pvt+Instrument PTS workgroup see( <http://www.gpo.gov/fdsys/pkg/FR-2013-04-24/pdf/2013-09684.pdf> )

If you would like to be part of the process, Please see the link above. The comment period was extended to 8 Jul. Also you may want to review this for the ideas included for the evolution of the Airman Certification Standards. The new Airman Certification Standards will eventually replace the PTS. At this time we are not sure when the change will take effect. The go around procedure will be modified and included in the new airman certification standards for the private pilot rating

**Bulletins:** Phil Rimmel has posted on a bulletin for Emergency Descents. We see confusion on testing for emergency descents especially in the private airplane applicants and the recommending instructors. Your input on defining some best practices for testing and preparing are needed. We need to consider configurations, speeds, and other factors that align with the PTS, and the Airplane Flying Handbook, and the AFM. Applicants are not correlating the different scenarios when applied to an emergency descent. An example is when an examiner will give an applicant a fire scenario; the applicant will start the emergency descent but won't complete the shutdown checklist to put the fire out.

There is a new proposal out for electronic flight displays and instrument flight tests.

**Airspace:** We must maintain vigilance (visually and radio monitoring) to mitigate conflicts. We know this is an emphasis area and both DPE and applicants being tested must always be aware of the potential for collision and use skills to avoid them. The PHAK states the pilot should be outside the aircraft for 9 out of 10 seconds.

**Best Practices:** (qualify, plan of action, questions, scenario triggers, self evaluation, 141 vs 61, feed back to schools/instructors).

We have established a new subcommittee to develop model plans of action starting with the private pilot practical test and moving on to others. Duncan Hastie will lead this group. You are invited to join the process and one way would be to provide examples (both good and not so) to him as part of the process to guide us to improving our plans and assist newer DPE with a better start.

### Continuing:

The Scenario Based Practical Test (**working paper is posted on the [www.AZDPEAG.org](http://www.AZDPEAG.org) website**) or see Sep 2011 Minutes. The intent behind scenario based testing is to include aeronautical decision making and judgment in the test process and to keep a test focus at the correlation level. Part of a process to further develop this could be the DPE working together to improve their plans of action and a wider discussion at a mid year meeting with greater attendance. We seek your input on improvements, additions and corrections.
